

How to Keep Your Requested Smart Trips Emails Out of your Spam Filter

If you requested monthly Smart Trips reminders or a new password, you may need to tell your spam filter to allow those emails.

Outlook 2003

You have several options to choose from:

1. Go to "Actions" on your e-mail menu bar. Select "Junk E-mail" from your pulldown menu. Select "Add Sender's Domain to Safe Senders List."
2. Right-click in the message and select "Add the Domain to Safe Senders List".
3. Go to Tools on the menu bar. Select "Options" in the pull-down menu. Under "Preferences", select "Junk E-mail". Then click on the "Safe Sender" tab. Click the "Add" button. Type "@WhatcomSmartTrips.org" in the text box.

AOL 9.0

Add the appropriate email address to your address book.

To receive our reminder emails, add the address "info@WhatcomSmartTrips.org".
To receive our new password emails, add "AutoPassword@WhatcomSmartTrips.org"

MSN Hotmail

Go to the "Options" page. On the left side of the page, click "Mail," and then click "Junk E-Mail Protection." Click "Add Senders to Safe List." Type "@WhatcomSmartTrips.org," and then click "Add."

Yahoo! Mail

Use the "Not Spam" button to report messages you want in your Inbox that were delivered to your Bulk folder.

Earthlink

If you have our email addresses in your Address Book, Earthlink will not block them. Go to your Address Book, click the "Add" button. You only need to enter the e-mail address under Internet Information.
